What is **RITA**?

The Regional Impact Trade Alliance (RITA) is an emerging international non-profit, civil society organisation that aspires to serve as an inter-regional trade platform for purpose-driven cities, regions, bio-regions and small nations, as well as to become a promotion body for a new global positioning of impact regions. Our purpose is to catalyze commercial competitive and collaborative advantages for cities and regions based on their responses to large scale social and environmental needs, creating good for the World and the Planet. Multi-sector collaboration, region-wide agreements and macro and micro economic innovations are the three minimum categories that enable membership.

Who is RITA?

The Regional Impact Trade Alliance has emerged from conversations and collaborations between passionate leaders in regions around the world. In November 2023, after three years of incubation by Regeneration Projects, **RITA will be formally established as a legal entity in Melbourne, Australia.** Matt Sykes will take on the Executive Director role with the support of diverse colleagues.


Case Study Melbourne x Mendoza
